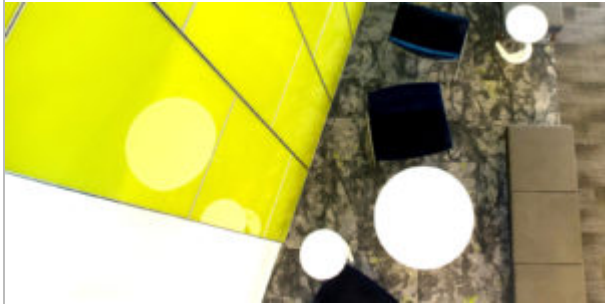


[Sycamore Career Summit](#)
