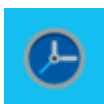

### [Bike share program launched](#)

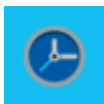

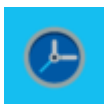

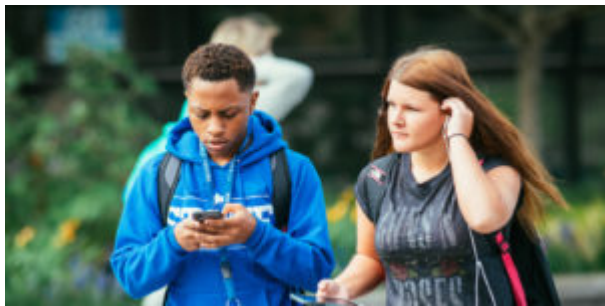
