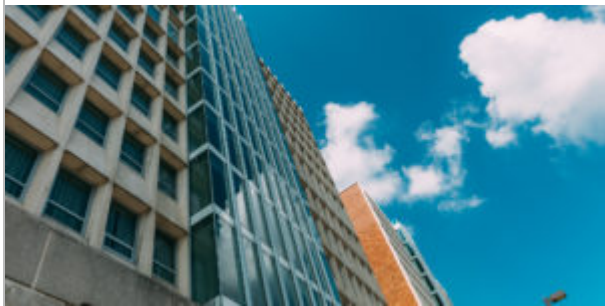
2018-19 Cheer Team Tryout
