**Presidential Meet and Greet, pregame event in Louisville**

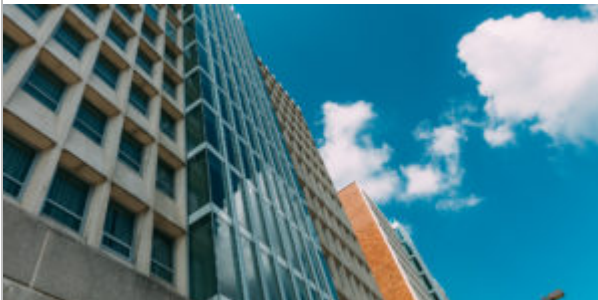
