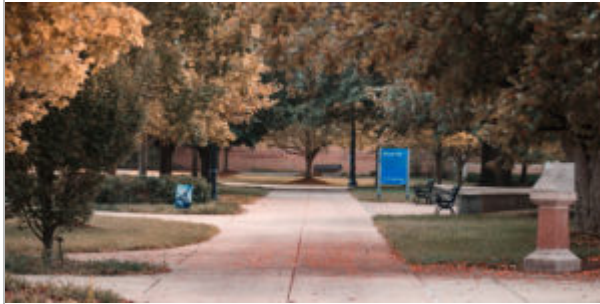
International Pronoun Day
