In an [interview](#) with *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, alumna Stacey Kostell recalled the process of applying to ISU.

“I grew up in a small town in Indiana, a rural student,” she said. “I always knew that I would go to college, but I don’t think I applied until February of my senior year. I don’t remember anyone having a conversation with me about it. A couple of good friends who were going to Indiana State University came home and told me that I should apply there. That was my whole college search.”

Kostell was announced Tuesday as the next CEO of the Coalition for College, a group that helps students plan for college starting early in high school and helps navigate the application process. She is currently Vice President for Enrollment Management at the University of Vermont.
