Summer 2020 athletics camps for youths canceled

Indiana State Director of Athletics Sherard Clinkscales announced the cancellation of all youth athletics camps scheduled on campus during the summer of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

ISU remains open and operational with online-only instruction continuing through the end of the spring semester.

"Our coaches will continue to be focused on getting our student-athletes ready for the upcoming year as well as recruiting for the future," Clinkscales said. "Our summer camps are traditionally a great way for the youth of the Wabash Valley to spend time on our campus and receive some of the best instruction available from our coaching staff.
