Reminder: May 1 is deadline for switching to satisfactory/unsatisfactory grading



Students will have the option of changing from A-through-F letter grades to Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grades for the Spring 2020 semester.

Students may select which of their courses they would like to switch, but students are strongly encouraged to work with their advisor when deciding. Program prerequisites that depend on students earning a sufficient letter grade in a course remain in effect, so students should not choose the S/U option in those courses.
