ISU vows to work with state on financial challenges during pandemic

Indiana State University participated in a discussion of the Federal CARES Act funding Wednesday at the [State Budget Committee](#) meeting in Indianapolis. During the discussion, State Budget Director Zac Jackson outlined the Budget Agency's plan that reduces state operating appropriations to public universities by 7 percent.

Greg Goode, ISU Executive Director for Government Relations and University Communication, was invited to comment before the Committee. Goode expressed ISU's appreciation for the past generous investment made in public higher education, including university operational support and funding for high-priority campus construction projects. Goode echoed President Deborah Curtis's commitment to being a strong partner with state leaders as Indiana navigates the economic challenges associated with the COVID-19 Pandemic. The 7 percent reduction amounts to about \$5.1 million less in revenue for the upcoming fiscal year. University officials will be working with academic and campus leadership on a plan to reduce expenditures accordingly.

The State Budget Committee is composed of four legislators – one Democrat and one Republican from both the House of Representatives and the Senate – and the Director of the Budget Agency. The Budget Committee holds public hearings with state agencies to outline their budget requests. After the hearings are completed and future revenue estimates are

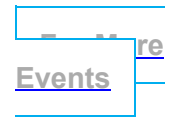
