Reminder: Safety guidelines against COVID-19 are still in effect



The safety guidelines that the university put in place to help safeguard all Sycamores against COVID-19 are still in effect. As we approach the flu season, and in order to continue to keep our case numbers low, it is critical for all students and employees to continue to:

- **#MaskUpSycamores.** Wear a mask in all campus buildings and indoor settings, as well as outdoor settings where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- **Wash your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds.** Use hand sanitizer and avoid touching your face, surfaces, shaking hands, and using hands to open doors when other methods are available.

- **Watch your Distance.** Maintain a minimum 6 feet distance between you and other individuals.
- **Disinfect the surfaces** you use for work and class.
- **Stay home when you are ill.**
- **Complete the Sycamore Symptom Assessment** if you plan to be on campus.

The [Fall Event Planning COVID-19 Related Guidance for Large Events and Gatherings](#) and the [Temporary Student Directives for the Prevention of COVID-19](#) will remain in effect for all in-person activities. Events and gatherings cannot exceed 50 people in attendance including event organizers and guest speakers. Athletics launches 'Step Up Initiative'
