Campus members encouraged to register for strategic planning sessions as development of 2021-2025 plan begins

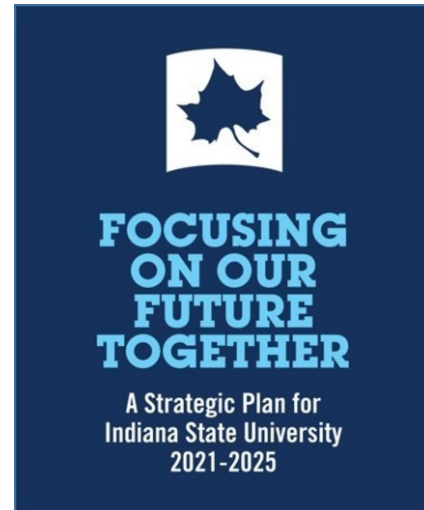
Work has started on the development of the University's next strategic plan, titled "Focusing on our Future Together: A Strategic Plan for Indiana State University, 2021-2025."

The priorities for the plan were established by the ISU Board of Trustees in a special meeting on Sept. 16. Those priorities, each focusing on student success, are:

- To prepare the workforce for Indiana and beyond
- Impact lives and communities
- Ensure equity and inclusiveness
- Increase institutional vitality, sustainability, and performance.

Members of the university's Strategic Planning Steering Committee convened on Sept. 21, and sessions with each governance unit as well as other key stakeholder groups have been set for the coming weeks. The planning process is being led by Dr. Brad Balch, dean emeritus and professor of educational leadership. Teresa Exline, chief of staff, chairs the steering committee.

Other campus members are encouraged to participate in the plan's development by registering to attend a small group session or one-on-one discussion with Dr. Balch. To register, go to:

"I'm excited to work with the Strategic Planning Steering Committee, the governance units, and other campus stakeholders this academic year as we focus on the means by which to address the university priorities approved by our Trustees," Balch said. "Now that the Trustees have codified what the priorities are, the campus community is being invited to participate in how to best address these priorities."

A campus-wide survey to garner additional feedback will be launched in mid-October.

Dr. Balch also led the review and revision of the University's Foundational Statements which took place during the 2019-2020 academic year.

A draft of the full plan will be shared with campus stakeholders and the trustees in February 2021 for feedback. In May 2021, trustees will be asked to endorse the final plan.
