Tobacco-Free Campus webpages are live

New web pages with tobacco cessation resources and Tobacco-Free Campus information are now available on Indiana State University's website.

The Tobacco-Free Campus web pages, at <https://www.indstate.edu/tobacco-free>, provide information on campus, local, state, and national tobacco cessation services for persons interested in quitting their tobacco use. Visitors can also learn more about the updated tobacco-free campus policy and current designated areas for tobacco use. Through the site, the ISU community can connect with tobacco-free campus ambassadors and complete a feedback form to help guide community outreach and support.



In May 2020, the Indiana State University Board of Trustees approved revisions to ISU's campus tobacco policy which is now known as the [Tobacco, Vapor and Smoke Free Campus policy](#). That summer, President Deborah Curtis formed an implementation team to address issues such as signage, education, peer advocacy, and communication. In coordination with University Communication, the Office of the President, and Facilities Management, the committee created and installed the "Tobacco, Vapor, & Smoke Free Campus" lettering on all university signs in the fall.

"The Tobacco-Free Campus Implementation Committee is working diligently to ensure a comprehensive approach toward a tobacco-free campus including but not limited to providing health education, connecting interested persons to cessation resources, placing signage, collaborating with campus and community partners, and more," said Katie Lugar, Tobacco-Free Campus Implementation Committee Chair.
