ISU announces more detail on lifting mask requirement for fully vaccinated people

Indiana State University has shown remarkable resilience over the past 14 months while negotiating the challenging terrain of the pandemic. We have had two in-person semesters on campus and four in-person Spring Commencement ceremonies. That is a credit to our devoted students, faculty, and staff.

Following [new guidance](#) from the Centers for Disease Control, ISU has lifted the mask mandate for people who are fully vaccinated. Those who are [fully vaccinated](#) do not have to wear a mask anywhere on campus. Those who are not fully vaccinated may be unmasked on campus only in a private office or private residence hall room.

We will rely on the same trust in our fellow Sycamores that has gotten us to this point. That is consistent with the trust necessary for self-reporting on the daily health assessment, cooperating with contact tracers, and following the more subtle aspects of CDC safety advice.

Our community rose to the challenge and will no doubt continue helping us return to normal life as soon as possible. ISU encourages everyone to get vaccinated.

In coming days, campus signage will be updated and we'll have more details regarding campus events and other topics. Decisions about protocols for the Fall Semester will be coming at a later date.
