Bowen is a junior Insurance & Risk Management and Financial Services double major as well as a student member on the Indiana Commission for Higher Education. Heim is a junior Insurance & Risk Management and Finance double major as well as President of the Scott College of Business Student Advisory Board.

“Ms. Bowen and Mr. Heim both have tremendous careers ahead of them and are very deserving of this wonderful recognition,” said Dr. Jin Park, chair of the Accounting, Finance, Insurance, and Risk Management Department. “We are grateful to the Spencer Educational Foundation for their support and pride ourselves in preparing students for success in the classroom and through industry engagement.”

This year, Spencer awarded 84 scholarships to full-time undergraduate, graduate, and part-time master’s students totaling \$503,500. Selection is based upon academics, leadership, industry interest, and experience.

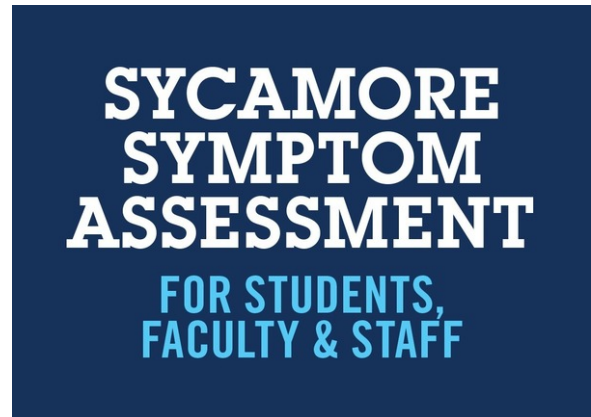
