ISU hosts Summer Games Torch Run

Indiana State University today welcomes law enforcement officers and supporters for the [2021 Summer Games Torch Run](#).

Registration opens at 10:30 a.m. The main event, also known as The Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics Indiana, begins at 11:30 a.m. at parking lot 21 on Fourth Street across from the College of Health and Human Services Building and just south of the softball field.

ISU Director of Public Safety and Chief of Police Michele Barrett will give a welcome and ISU police officers will escort the runners through the route.

Known as Guardians of the Flame, runners carry the "Flame of Hope" for Special Olympics athletes, "symbolizing courage and [a] celebration of diversity," according to Special Olympics Indiana.



"Traditionally culminating with the lighting of the cauldron during Opening Ceremonies (which will take place virtually this year), the 2021 Summer Games Torch Run instead includes a celebratory luncheon and an opportunity to record messages of support and encouragement for all those competing in our first in-person Summer Games in two years."

The luncheon is sponsored by the ISU Police Department.

Summer Games competition will take place on June 12-13 at Indiana State University and Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology.
