Terre Haute Rotary Club honors Diann McKee

ISU Senior Vice President of Finance and Administration and University Treasurer Diann McKee is the 2021 recipient of the Paul Harris Community Award by the Terre Haute Rotary Club.

The award recognizes a non-Rotarian community member who exemplifies the Rotary motto, "Service Above Self," and has made a significant impact on the community.



According to the Rotary Club, McKee was chosen for her decades-long service to ISU and the community. Her ISU career spans nearly 35 years with service as chief financial officer for 13 years. She has overseen more than \$420 million of construction on and near the ISU campus during her tenure and her responsibilities expanded over time to include campus public safety, oversight for construction, maintenance, environmental safety, human resources, and all financial functions of the university.

"Diann has worked tirelessly in her role at Indiana State to carry out the ideal of service above

self,” said Josh Zuerner, founder and President of Joink, Inc., the Rotarian who nominated McKee for the honor. “I look at Diann as someone who not only helped to sustain the ‘business’ of Indiana State, but someone who has been in the forefront of growing it during her career.”

McKee will be recognized at the Terre Haute Rotary Club’s regular meeting at noon on Tuesday, June 15, in the MCL Banquet Center.
