The Charles E. Brown African American Cultural Center (AACC) at Indiana State University will host the 2nd annual Juneteenth Celebration from 1-3 p.m. on Saturday, June 19.

The event — which will take place at the Center, 301 North 8th Street — will feature a panel discussion plus culturally relevant music and food.
