#### Free engineering and technology camp available for high school girls

On July 19-23, the College of Technology at Indiana State University will host a [virtual engineering and technology summer camp](#) for high school girls. The camp is funded by the Indiana Space Grant Consortium, a nonprofit organization that serves as a source of NASA-related information, awards, and programs.

There is no cost to attend the camp.

"It is important that high school girls consider engineering and technology among their career choices," said Maria Javaid, Ph.D., assistant professor of Electronics and Computer Engineering Technology. "This virtual camp funded by NASA is an attempt to introduce girls to engineering and technology."

The camp will take place virtually from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Guided by ISU faculty and students, topics include electric circuits through conductive ink; 3D printing through flywheel project; virtual industrial robots and automation lab activity; and virtual unmanned systems lab tour and drone activity.
