## Faculty Fellows announced for Academic Affairs

Dr. Lucy Campbell, Dr. Robert Guell, and Dr. Haijing Tu will work as Faculty Fellows in Academic Affairs for 2021-22, Interim Provost Christopher Olsen announced.

"We are so fortunate and grateful to have help from Drs. Tu, Guell, and Campbell this coming year," Olsen said. "They all have experience with curriculum, assessment, and recruiting, among other areas, and will help us move our strategic initiatives forward."

"With the elimination of two AVP positions in the past few years, their willingness to lend us their expertise is particularly critical as we launch ISU's new strategic plan."

Dr. Campbell will serve as a Faculty Fellow in Academic Affairs starting in July, 2021, working primarily with the Office of the Vice Provost and Admissions. Her primary responsibilities will be to help design materials and outreach to students and families who identify as

Hispanic/Latino, working with ISU’s Admissions staff in high schools and on campus.

Dr. Campbell, a Lecturer in the Department of Languages, Literatures, and Linguistics, was born and raised in Colombia, South America. After graduating from Pamplona University in Colombia she relocated to the United States and completed a Master’s in Spanish and Literature and a Ph.D. in Curriculum and Instruction in Language Education.

Dr. Guell began this month, working to advance strategic initiatives in the Provost’s office. Dr. Guell will be facilitating conversations and proposals with faculty, deans, and the Faculty Senate, and working also with the administration in Academic Affairs and the ISU Foundation.

His responsibilities will focus initially on potential new programs and distance education but may evolve over the course of the year to other units and potential projects. Dr. Guell is a Professor of Economics, where he teaches and writes on a range of topics.

Dr. Tu has been serving as a Faculty Fellow in Academic Affairs since June 2020, working with curriculum matters, course and program fees, and assisting with program reviews. Dr. Tu does all initial consultation with programs about curricular changes, as well as the initial Academic Affairs review, and represents Academic Affairs at university-level curriculum committees.

Dr. Tu works closely with Dr. Susan Powers and the Registrar’s Office in these activities. Dr. Tu is Associate Professor of Communication, with specialties in cross-cultural media studies and social media.
